

Family Prize Quiz Trail

Follow the instructions to be taken on a tour around Worcester, answer the questions as you go and when you have finished return the form to The Tourist Information Centre to be in with a chance to win a special prize!



Allow approximately 45 minutes for the walk.

Come out of the TIC office on to the High Street and turn left.

1) What number High Street is Worcester City Council Customer Services?

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Turn left into Crowngate. Walk down the slope passed Huntingdon Hall, towards the pillars.

2) In what restaurant might you beware of dangerous animals?

Fork right at the pillars.

3) Which shop might you find at the top of a steep hill?

Turn left before the car park and walk up the Hill

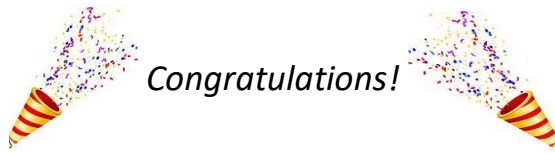
18) What is the number of the lamp post by the bollards?
